

Here is the information you will need to complete your request:

Note that the information requested in the form is largely inspired by the FRQS forms. If you already have this information up to date, you can simply "copy and paste" it into the form. If this is not the case, we encourage you to use this opportunity to open a FRQS file and/or update it.

*To complete the form, you must log on to your account in the CTRN website. This will allow you to **save your application** if you don't complete it all at once.*

Basic information about you and your supervisor: names, emails, research field and sub-field, your faculty, your program, your current session (if your doctorate has started), your university studies (name of diplomas, program, university, date of registration and date of graduation obtained or planned (if applicable))

The list of your grants and awards (organization, name of the grant or award, amount, start and end dates), if applicable

Your title and project summary

Summary for the general public: brief description of your research program or project. This part corresponds to the "Lay Summary" section of the FRQS "Application Form". Limit of 500 words and 3500 characters, spaces included. If you exceed the number of characters allowed, you will receive an error message when submitting the form

Description of the research project

You must clearly describe your research project, respecting the following sections: A. the research questions and hypotheses B. the research objectives C. the methods and analyses D. the feasibility E. the contributions to the knowledge advancement F. a maximum of 6 bibliographical references. // The text can be written in French or in English / This part corresponds to the "Project description" section of the FRQS "Application form". Limit of 10,500 characters, spaces included. If you exceed the number of characters allowed, you will receive an error message when submitting the form.

Skills and experiences

You must describe your participation in research projects and research training placements during your previous studies. Identify the projects and internships supervisors; indicate the start and end date of each activity. Specify whether these research training placements were compulsory or voluntary. This part corresponds to the "Skills and Experience" section of the FRQS "Application Form". Limit of 6,000 characters, spaces included. If you exceed the number of characters allowed, you will receive an error message when submitting the form.

Research supervisor's text (To be provided by your research supervisor)

This section corresponds to the "Integration research program" part, to be completed by the research supervisors in the documents required by the FRQS. Copy, in this section, a text provided by your supervisor explaining how your research project fits into their research program. Limit of 500 words and 4,000 characters, spaces included. If you exceed the number of characters allowed, you will receive an error message only when submitting the form.

Advanced stage justification (To be provided by your supervisor)

For students between the 5th and 9th doctoral session only: the research supervisor must provide a text explaining why you deserve the CTRN scholarship at an advanced stage of your training.

Academic transcripts

You will need to attach a copy of your university transcript (the original is not required). If you have more than one documents, please merge them in one PDF document.

Justification of grades

You must assess, in a few words, your level of academic excellence. Justify where you stand in relation to the average of your study program. If necessary, put your grades in perspective in relation to the particularities of your program, your group and/or the grading system of the country where your studies were carried out. You can also comment on your progress during the program or justify periods of difficulty. Limit of 300 words.
